You are expected to do each of the following as we read the book.

#### Reading Reviews - Wednesdays

Plan to read three chapters a week. Each Wednesday there will be a guided reading review on the three chapters.

#### Animal List — Due \_\_\_\_\_

Keep a list of the animals mentioned in the story. As the trimester progresses you will be able to group the animals in the correct phyla.

### Vocabulary List — Due \_\_\_\_\_

Keep a list of the words that are new to you. Use a dictionary to learn the meaning of each word, or infer what it means from the story.

Choose one of these activities to do. Tell the teacher by \_\_\_\_\_\_which one you will be doing.

### **Animal Report**

Choose an animal from the story and write a report on it. The report should include the following.

A description of the animal's physical characteristics: coloration, size, and shape.

Describe its habitat. Explain where it lives.

How does it get food?

What does it eat?

What time of day is it out?

How does it protect itself?

Include a picture or sketch.

Write a story told by an animal. Illustrate it with photos or sketches.

Make a book or board using photos that goes along with Grouper Moon.

Write a persuasive essay on the value of preserving the coral reef ecosystem.

Do you have another idea? Discuss it with the teacher.
